#### **ANSON JONES, PATRIOT AND MASON**

Anson Jones mason, soldier, statesman and the first Grand Master of Texas memorialize his recollection of events that brought masonry to Texas. The winter of 1834-1835 brought five Texans known to each other as Master Masons and they were J.H. Wharton, A. Brigham, J.A.E. Phelps, A. Russell, and Anson Jones. They met and resolved to form a Texas Lodge at 10am in a secluded grove of peach and laurel trees and also a burial ground near Brazoria, Texas.

Also at this time a sixth Master Mason became known, J.P. Caldwell along with the five others concluded to apply to the Grand lodge of Louisiana for a dispensation which after some time were signed by others that became known and forwarded to New Orleans. On December 27th 1835 Holland Lodge No.36 in Brazoria, Texas, under dispensation held its first meeting on the second floor of the courthouse.

During this same time period the growing distrust by the Mexican Government which already had its spies and intending to enforce its rule with harsh measures in the territory and fearing the questioning of its absolute authority, were thus so laid in place the beginnings of Texas's War of Independence against a despotic central government ruled by an elite class similar to European models of government. The fraternal bonds which bring men together in union became a uniting and release of self-fear in the face of this tyranny.

Shortly after this first meeting open hostilities broke out and many members were scattered in service to the country. The last meeting was held in February 1886 and in March Brazoria was occupied and all lodge records, books jewels and its dispensation were destroyed, however the Charter was not lost as it was in transit. During this time two other lodges were chartered Milarn in Naeogdoches McFarlane in San Augustine. After the deciding Battle of San Jacinto in 1837 that October Holland Lodge No. 36 reopened again in the City of Houston Texas. In the winter of 1837-1838 the Grand Lodge of Texas in Houston came into being and Holland Lodge No.36 became A.F.& A.M. Holland Lodge No.1 with Anson Jones becoming the First Grand Master of Texas
